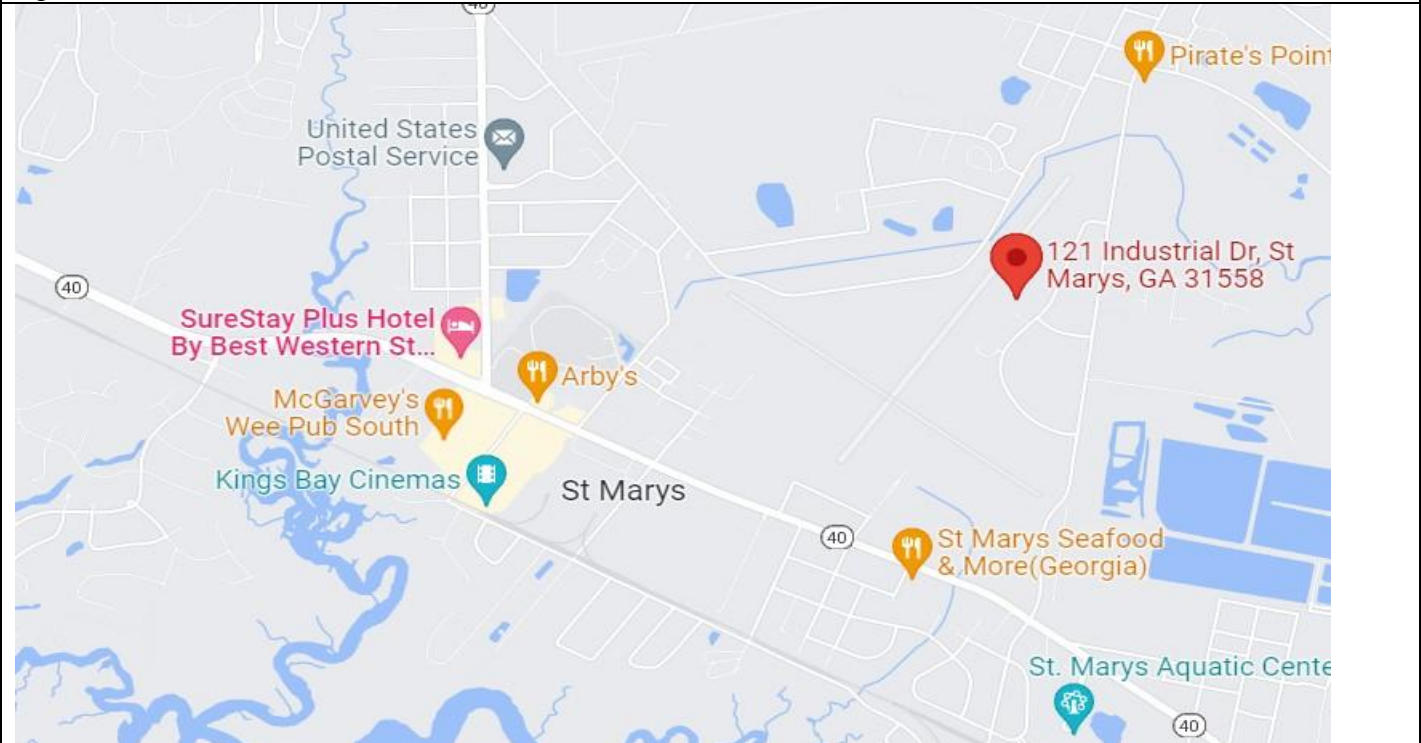

Coming from the North Take I-95 Exit 3 to GA-40 east. In about 6.5 miles take a left onto Point Peter Road then a left on Plant Way then a right on Industrial Drive.

Coming from the South Take I-95 Exit 1 and turn Right (east) on St Mary's Rd. In 3 miles Take exit on Right for GA-40 east. In about 2.8 miles take a left onto Point Peter Road then a left on Plant Way then a right on Industrial Drive.

Minor waivers are available but must be signed by the parent or legal guardian in the presence of the registrar.

To join NCCC, bring a check to the event for membership and another for the entry fee (cash works too).

Membership dues are \$35.00 per year for Enthusiast and \$10.00 for their spouse.

The membership check will be to NCCC, the entry to NFCA!

We will have the Region Membership Director with her lap top joining people into the National Club the morning of the event.

You may join on the day of the event but must pay with separate cash or check from the event entry fee.
